#### **5.10 Homeschool or Online Student Athletes**

Students who homeschool or attend an online school who request to compete for a current CAA member school must submit the CAA General Appeal form before the start of that sports season must update student enrollment count to the association by resubmitting the student enrollment verification form. The student must submit the following items to the receiving school's Athletic Director:

- \* Letter from parent
- \* Letter stating homeschool curriculum
- \* Birth Certificate
- \* Current schedule of classes
- \* Verify passing current classes
- \* Affidavit from the state department of education (Homeschool only)
- \* or Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) approval document

Note: If your school had filed the paperwork before this decision by the Executive Board, please follow the new process for reporting out students under Article 5.10

## **New Business:**

## HeadStrong Concussion Insurance Program - Quick Synopsis

- Purpose: Designed to protect student-athletes from the high costs associated with concussion treatment and neurological follow-up
- Coverage Details:
  - o Provides first-dollar coverage with \$0 deductible and no co-pays.
  - o Acts as secondary/excess insurance, paying after the primary insurance—but becomes the primary payor if no other insurance is available.
  - Covers up to \$25,000 per injury, including neurological follow-up, and includes
     \$5,000 Accidental Death & Dismemberment benefit.
- Additional Benefits:
  - o Telemedicine services when needed
  - o No restrictions on provider choice and no referrals required
  - No internal limits or procedure maximums, with billing at Usual & Customary
- Eligibility: Covers all athletes participating in school-sponsored practices and competitions, subject to the specific governing body's participation rules
