#### *8.2 Regular Season Contests*

*8.2.1 Once the mandatory schedule is released to the member schools the following procedures should be followed.*

*8.2.1.1 Athletic Director will be responsible for communicating and scheduling all mandatory games.*

*8.2.1.1.1 Failure to schedule a mandatory game will result in postseason ineligibility*

After full review and discussion, the Board has determined that any rainout or unplayable field condition due to weather in Season 2 with an appeal submitted will be classified as a no contest. This ruling will not impact your team's eligibility for postseason play, nor will it result in a violation for not completing the full 10-game mandatory schedule.

## **VIOLATION REPORT**

### **Article 10: Penalties and Fines**

**10.2.4 PROBATION** – *Probation is a testing or trial period for a school or team. Probation is equivalent to a larger penalty should the probation not be carried out in good faith and with due respect to all concerned.*

**10.2.4.4** *Prohibition from participation in one or more CAA tournaments for one or more years.*

**10.2.4.5** *Prohibition of hosting one or more CAA tournaments.*
